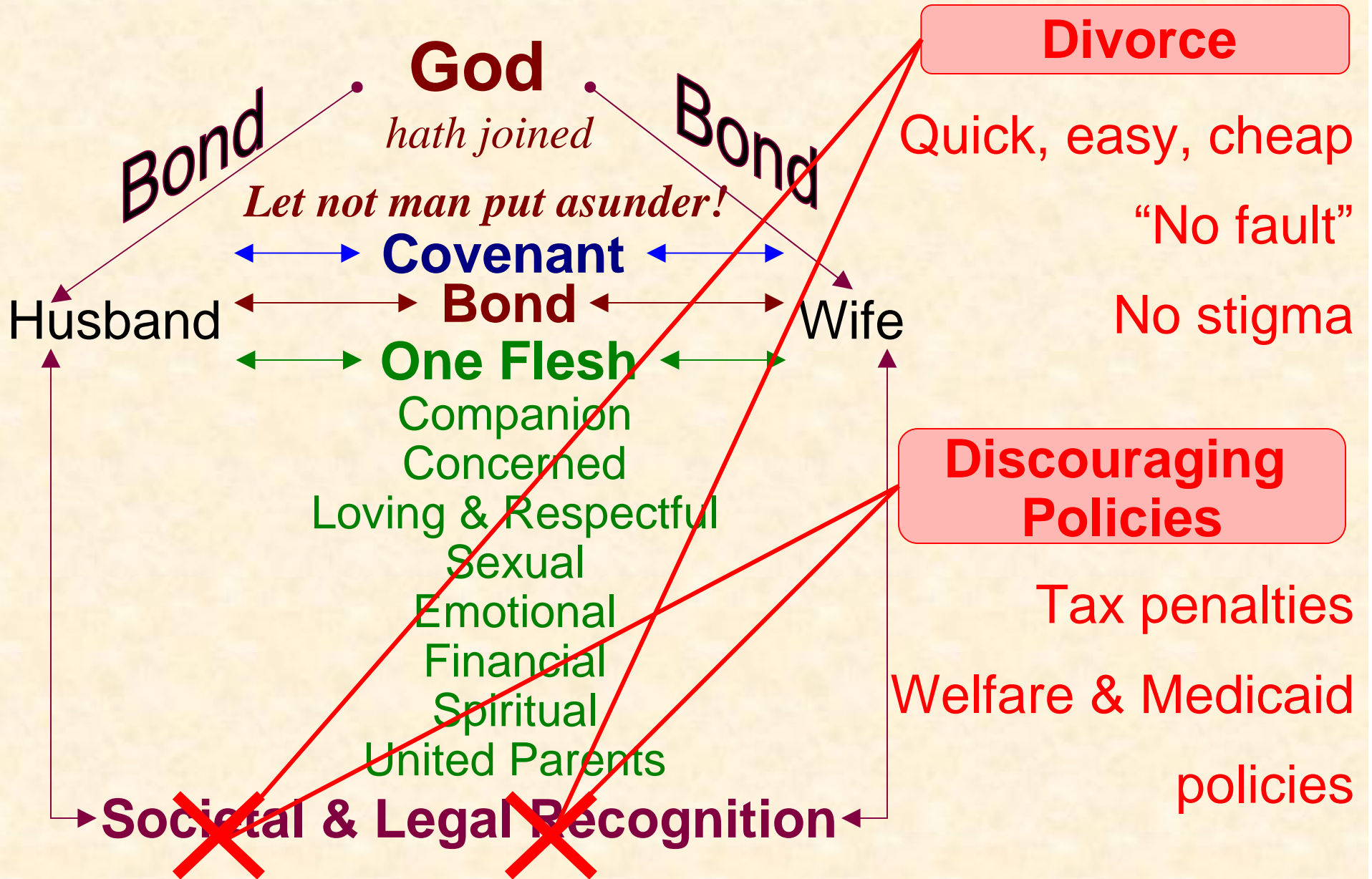

Scriptural Divorce

Only One Exception To God's Rule



Only When Other Spouse Is Sexually Active Outside Marriage

This is the **only** violation that allows any to:

- 1.) sever their covenant
- 2.) be released by God
- 3.) rightly seek legal recognition

Matt 19:9
